#### 1. Aim

- popularization of Combat Sambo as the universal system of Martial arts.
- propaganda of healthy life-style.

#### 2. Place and date

Competitions are held on October 13-14, 2018 in Ostrava, Czech .

**18:00 – 19:00** - weighting in all weight category;

**14.10.2018.**

- **09:00 – 14:00** – preliminary rounds in all weight category;
- **14:00 - 15:00** - a break;
- **15:00** – a solemn opening;
- **16:00** – finals in all weight category;
- **19:00** – rewarding.

### **3. Tournament Participants**

15 years old and elder sportsmen, representatives of the Universal Combat Sambo Federation, International, National Federations, Combat Sambo Clubs of other countries and also representatives of other kinds and schools of martial arts all over the world are allowed to participate in the competitions.

### **4. Weight Categories**

- Competition participants are divided into the following weight categories:

**youth (2004-2005 y.b.)**

less than 36 kg, less than 39 kg, less than 42 kg, less than 45 kg, less than 48 kg, less than 52 kg, less than 57 kg, less than 62 kg, less than 68 kg, less than 74 kg, more than 74 kg.

**youth (2002-2003 y.b.)**

less than 39 kg, less than 42 kg, less than 45 kg, less than 48 kg, less than 52 kg, less than 57 kg, less than 62 kg, less than 68 kg, less than 74 kg, less than 82 kg, more than 82 kg.

**Juniors (2000-2001 y.b.)**

less than 52 kg, less than 57 kg, less than 62 kg, less than 68 kg, less than 74 kg, less than 82 kg, less than 90 kg, more than 90 kg.

**Men (1999 r y.b, and old)**

less than 57 kg, less than 62 kg, less than 68 kg, less than 74 kg, less than 82 kg, less than 90 kg, more than 90 kg.

### **5. Tournament Rules and Manual**

- individual and team championship;

- Competitions are held in accordance with the Rules of the Universal Combat Sambo Federation,

Based on Olympic system (by leaving the field), sportsmen who lost to the finalists participate in the consoling fights for the third place.

The Panel of Judges agreed by the Organizing Committee is responsible for direct Competition (duels) holding.

## **6. Duel Continuance**

For youth and boys:

- preliminary rounds last for 4 minutes each;
- semi-final and final fights last for 4 minutes each;
- 2 minutes overtime without break is added in case of equal scoring.

For men:

- preliminary rounds last for 5 minutes each;
- semi-final and final fights last for 5 minutes each;
- 2 minutes overtime without break is added in case of equal scoring.

## **7. Clothes, Footwear and Equipment of the Participants**

- Competitions are held in accordance with the Rules of the European Combat Sambo Federation, - Soft protective helmet without a visor with an open jaw.
- Sportswear of participants, according to the Rules: a jacket for fights in combat sambo, belt and pants in red or blue colors corresponding to the color of the jacket. The use of caps, shells and open soft gloves mandatory. Sports shoes with soft soles are not allowed to speak without shoes;

## **8. Values of Technical Moves (Techniques)**

Quality and values of technical moves depend on participant positions in relation to the mat surface before and after these moves to be applied.

- a) 2 points – the participant is scored for the technique as the result of which the defensive wrestler falls on following parts of the body: side, back, breast, stomach, buttocks, waist, shoulder and his opponent is still in the standing position;
- b) 1 point – the participant is scored for the technique as the result of which the defensive wrestler falls on the part of the body and his opponent is in the lying position above or aside; attacker`s moves are not scored, if he stays below.
- c) 1 point – the attacking wrestler is scored for moves after punch or throw, if his opponent falls on his knee (knees) supported by his arm (arms), the attacking wrestler is still in the standing position.
